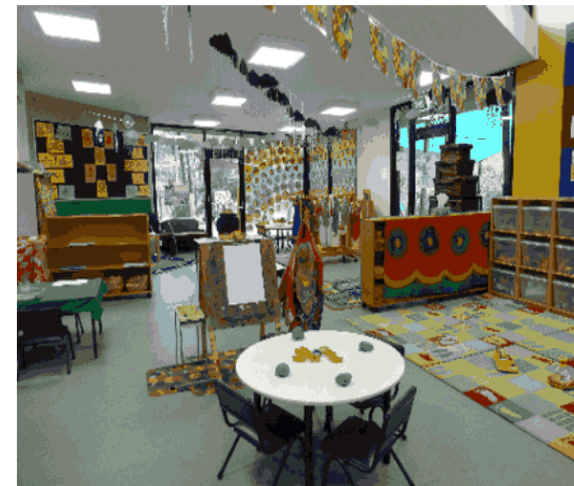

Children bring their own healthy snack from home for snack time at Occasional Care.

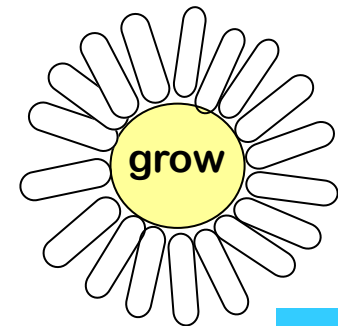
Experiences are presented in both the indoor and outdoor environments and are a mix of child initiated and teacher initiated learning.
